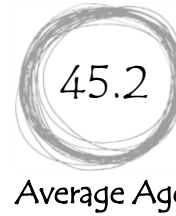


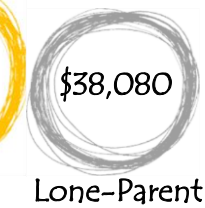
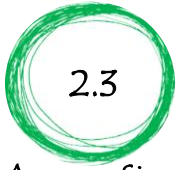
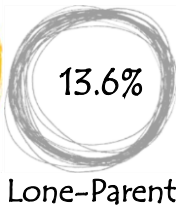
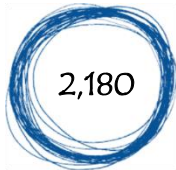
2016 Census Highlights – MOA – SUBDIVISION C



Between 2011 and 2016, the population decreased by 69 or -1.4%.

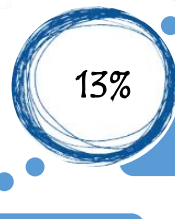
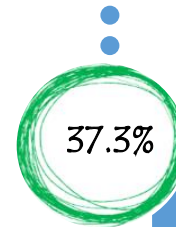
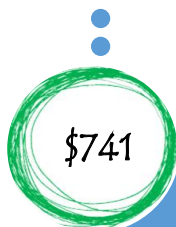


In the past 5 years, the median age of the population has increased by approximately 2.5 years.



The number of households is increasing. No other significant changes in this data set since 2011.

Households below low income measure has not significantly changed since 2011.



Since 2011, tenant shelter costs have increased 19.6%. Homeowner shelter costs have increased 5.9%.



Core Housing need has decreased by approximately 1% over the last 5 years.
