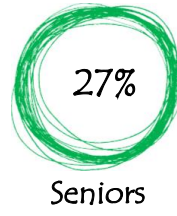
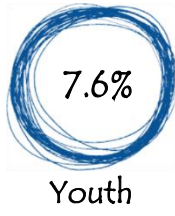
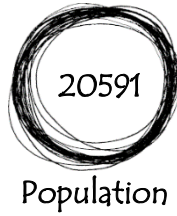


2016 Census Highlights – ANNAPOLIS COUNTY (includes towns)

In the past 5 years, the median age of the population has increased by 2.6 years.



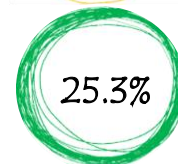

Median Household Income

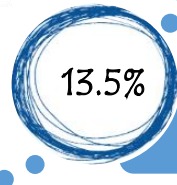
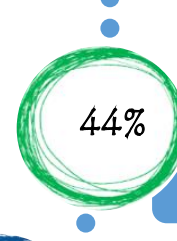
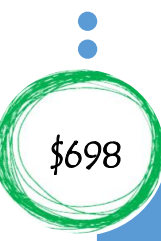


Average Size
