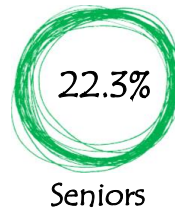


2016 Census Highlights – TOWN OF KENTVILLE



Between 2011 and 2016, the population increased by 2.9%, and the population by youth decreased by 1.0%.

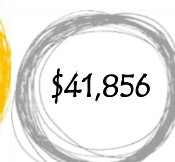

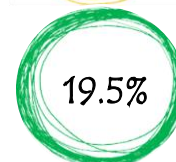

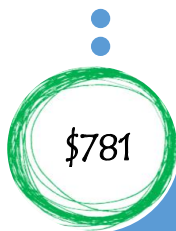

The number of households has increased by 3.2 %, but the average number of persons per household is shrinking.



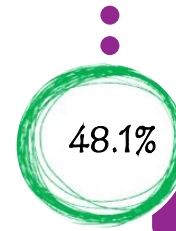
Households below low income measure has decreased by 0.8% since 2011

Core Housing Need



Since 2011, tenant shelter costs have increased 13%. Homeowner shelter costs have increased 11.2%.
