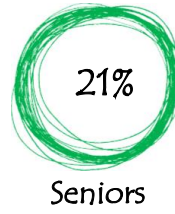
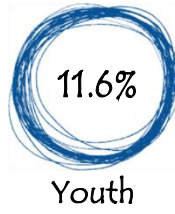
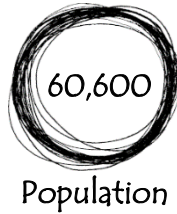


# 2016 Census Highlights –KINGS COUNTY

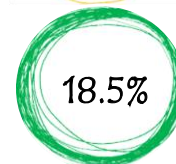

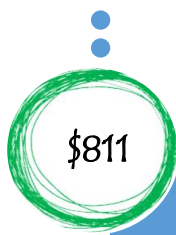

Core Housing Need
