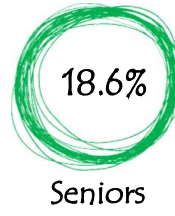


2016 Census Highlights – Municipality Kings- SUBDIVISION A



Between 2011 and 2016, the population increased by 0.6%, and the population by youth decreased by 0.1%.



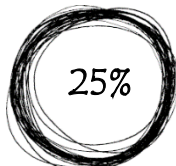
In the past 5 years, the median age of the population has increased by 3.8 years.

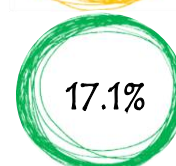

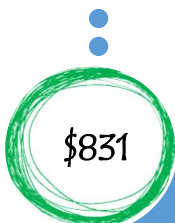

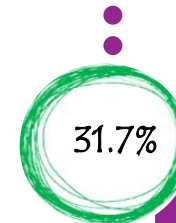
The number of households has increased by 2.9 %, but the average number of persons per household is shrinking.

Core Housing Need



Since 2011, tenant shelter costs have increased 15.4%. Homeowner shelter costs have increased 9%.
